Pregnancy in an Abusive Relationship, Often Overlooked Lethality Factor
By Panel, including Ruth Downing, MSN, RN, CNP, SANE-A, Forensic Nursing Network, Allison Levering, BSN, MS, CNP, OB/GYN Clinic, OSU Wexner Medical Center, Beverly Roseman-Shapiro, MSW, LISW-S, Project S.A.F.E. Coordinator, OSU Wexner Medical Center, & Alexis Winfield, OB Social Worker, Columbus Public Health & Primary One.

Dr Bresler will focus on the progression & cycle of behavior that characterize male violence & aggression in IPV relationships, using a series of letters from the abuser to the victim from courtship to marriage & the escalation of violence. He will also offer how to identify persons at risk for this type of aggression & provide recommended treatment interventions.

Panel members will describe reproductive coercion, increased risks for injury & homicide during pregnancy & suggest connections with pre-term births, adverse birth outcomes & infant mortality, as well as identify pregnancy as a lethality factor in DV relationships.
