^{***} Current Ohio law doesn't recognize "choking" (or non-fatal strangulation) as a felony, and yet even when homicide does not result, it can have a lasting adverse impact. ACTION is working with others to educate law makers about its lethality. If "choking" is recognized for what it is – abusers may face higher penalties and more victims will avoid becoming homicide statistics.

A victim writes: "He told me several times after he strangled me that he wasn't trying to kill me, that he was just trying to show me that he had the power to kill me. Domestic violence laws have changed, but not enough."
