The number of abused and neglected children in Ohio is staggering. Too many children are being abused in places where children should be safe from harm — in their own homes and their own communities. Too many children are being injured or killed by those entrusted to protect them — parents, step-parents, parent's boy/girlfriend, and caretakers. Child abuse frequently co-occurs with domestic violence. How can we identify the early signs before it's too late?
