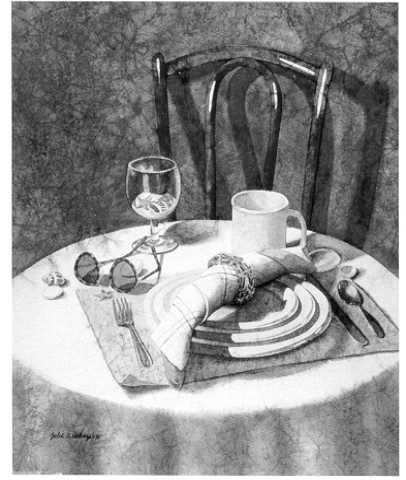


# *An Empty Place at the Table™ Memorial Exhibit*
